<p>Matthew 21:22 NIV</p> <p><i>"If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer."</i></p> <p>Jesus, with his disciples in tow, saw a fig tree and examined it, but found that it had no fruit – just leaves. So, Jesus cursed the fig tree! The next day the disciples were amazed that the fig tree had completely withered. Jesus had cursed the fig tree because it was barren, representing those who profess to believe, but do not demonstrate by thought, word or deed, nor produce spiritual fruit as evidence of their faith. He is all-knowing and ever-present, and we can stand in awe and witness His almighty power as He delivers us from the turmoil that is surrounding us.</p>	<p>PHILIPPIANS 4:13</p> <p><i>"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me!"</i></p> <p>Written by the Apostle Paul, this verse is so familiar that it is printed on everything! Even the non-religious community is familiar with this verse. The phrase, “I can do all things,” is often taken out of context. When Paul wrote this to the Philippians, he had experienced what it was like to be lacking, to be without food, to face hardships and physical trials because he had lived these experiences. Thus Philippians 4:13 is Paul’s advice on how to overcome the TRIALS OF LIFE, and how to be content with your current circumstances. Also read Philippians 4:16.</p>
